



**Mother's Day Invitational
Baseball/Softball Tournament**

Thank you for participating in our Mother's Day Invitational combined baseball/fast pitch softball tournament. We hope that your experience in our tournament will be a good one.

Each game will have "official" sanctioned umpires. Game balls will be provided by the tournament. All balls must be returned to the umpires at the conclusion of each game.

McCune Park complex provides a "full" concession stand for your appetite and thirst pleasure with a variety of menu items for your enjoyment.

McCune Park complex does not allow PETS, GRILLS, ALCHOHOL or FIRE ARMS on the premises.

A GATE FEE of \$3.00 PER PERSON PER DAY will be charged. Children 12 and under are free.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Teams are to register and check in as early as possible prior to their first game (minimum 30 minutes prior to scheduled start time).
2. At the registration check-in, teams are to provide the following items:
 - a. Telephone numbers for managers/coaches where they can be reached when not at the tournament. (for those staying in hotels/motels: list the name of the establishment, phone number and room number)
3. The tournament will consist of “pool play” games. Pool play ranking will be used to seat the teams for the championship round. All teams advance to the single elimination championship round.
4. Forfeit time is the scheduled start time of the game. NO FORFEITS by umpires, only by tournament director or his assistant.
5. There will be a coin toss to determine the home team prior to each game.
6. **The home team will be the official scorekeeper.**
7. Pool play and championship round games (except the final championship game):
 - a. For softball: 6 innings for 10u and 12u and 7 innings for 15u with a **90 minute drop dead time limit. No new inning will begin after 80 minutes.** If the 80 minute time limit expires, teams will complete the current inning unless home team is ahead.
 - b. For baseball:
 - i. Innings: 6 innings for 10u and 12u; 7 innings for 14u
 - ii. Time Limits:
 1. 10u: a **1 hour and thirty five minute drop dead time limit (Pool play only)**
 2. 12u and 14u: a **1 hour and 45 minute drop dead time limit. No new inning will begin after an hour and thirty minutes.** If the hour and thirty minute time limit expires, teams will complete the current inning unless home team is ahead.
 3. 10u, 12u and 14u: **Championship rounds will have a 1 hour and 45 minute drop dead time limit. No new inning will begin after an hour and thirty minutes.**
 - iii. **Pitching rules: 10 innings for the tournament; 40 hr. rest for more than 3 innings in a day**
8. There will be a ten (10) run rule after 4 ½ innings if the home team is winning or after 5 innings if the visiting team is winning for 15u softball and baseball; 3 ½ innings if the home team is winning or 4 innings if the visiting team is winning for 10u and 12u softball and baseball.
9. **The manager of the winning team must report the score to the tournament director or his assistant within 30 minutes from the end of the game. Non-reported games will result in a loss to both teams!**



10. For pool play, when a tie exists the following score book tie-breakers will be used if the time limit has been reached or at the end of 6 innings (10u, 12u softball and baseball) or 7 innings (15u softball and 14u baseball)
 - a. Base-runners advanced to third base,
 - b. Base-runners advanced to second base,
 - c. Base-runners advanced to first base,
 - d. A coin toss (coin to be tossed by the umpire or tournament official)
11. Final rankings will be based on the team's pool play won-loss record. If a tie exists, the tie-breakers will be: 1) head-to-head pool game (if played); 2) total runs allowed; 3) total runs scored; 4) a coin toss being the last resort.
12. For the championship round games, when a tie exists at the end of regulation innings or the time limit has been reached, the International Tie Breaker will be employed. "Starting with the top of the eighth inning or top of seventh for 10u and 12u baseball and softball and each half inning thereafter, the offensive team shall begin its turn at bat with the player who is scheduled to bat last in the respective half inning being placed on second base."
13. For the final championship game, at the end of 6 innings for 10u and 12u baseball and softball and 7 innings for 14u baseball and 15u softball, if a tie exists, the International Tie Breaker will be employed. There will be no time limit.
14. There will be a \$100.00 protest fee that is refunded if the team filing the protest wins the protest. The protest committee will be composed of the Tournament Director, his assistant and Tournament UIC.
15. The Tournament Director reserves the right to modify the tournament if necessary due to weather, etc.
16. In order to stay as close as possible to the schedule, all teams should be ready to enter the dugout and play 15 minutes prior to the schedule start time of the game.

Softball:

10u

1. Teams can bat their entire roster
2. Ten defensive players – 4 infielders, 4 outfielders, pitcher & catcher
3. Runners cannot leave until ball passes home plate
4. **NO STEALING HOME**
5. Five (5) run limit per inning except for the last inning. Last inning, unlimited runs

12u

1. Teams can elect to have an EP (extra player) which must be declared before game starts.
2. **PONY** softball rules will apply with exception for game time limit

15u

1. Teams can elect to have an EP (extra player) which must be declared before game starts.
2. **PONY** softball rules will apply with exception for game time limit.



Baseball:

Bat rule is as follows:...”with the exception of -3 BBCOR, all 2 ¼ and 2 5/8 barrel bats **must be certified with the “USA” stamp in league and/or tournament play.** 2 ¼ and 2 5/8 barrel bats are legal in all divisions of PONY baseball.”

10u

1. Teams can bat their entire roster
2. Ten defensive players – 4 infielders, 4 outfielders, pitcher & catcher
3. Runners cannot leave until ball passes home plate
4. **NO STEALING HOME**
5. Five (5) run limit per inning except for the last inning. Last inning, unlimited runs.

12u

1. Will be a 50/70 division. Pitching distance = 50 ft. Base distance = 70 ft.
2. **PONY** baseball rules will apply with exception for game time limit.

14u

1. **PONY** baseball rules will apply with exception for game time limit
